The Tryon Center for Visual Art is mounting its inaugural exhibition this fall of work by artists that have experienced a residency at one of the many artist communities around the country and abroad. We are hoping to include you in this exhibition as worked at Atlantic Center for the Arts in Florida with Suzanne Fetscher.

Bank of America (headquartered in Charlotte) has provided our new center with a beautifully renovated, \$7 million facility with state-of-the-art equipment in a 1926 neo-gothic church, and an endowment. The potential for this program and its impact nationally and internationally is tremendous. Suzanne Fetscher is President as well as current Chair of the Alliance of Artists' Communities.

I am writing to request your assistance in the loan of a video installation to include in the exhibition slated for September 16 - December 15, 1999. Works would need to in the center by mid-August and be fully insured in transit and in our facility. We would like participating artists to write a short statement (a paragraph or couple sentences) about the value of residency programs. These statements will be installed next to the respective artist's work. In this way, we will provide the general public insight into the value of a program that supports individual artists and the creative process.
