

The Artists' TV Lab

The Artists' TV Lab is a resource center with 1/2" color and black-and-white videotape production, processing and editing equipment.

The Lab has been established to encourage artists of all disciplines to explore the video medium. A limited number of artists-in-residence will be selected monthly for free access to Lab facilities on a scheduled basis. They may also be housed at the WCV studio while working on their projects.

The Lab consists of the following equipment: a 3130-8650 editing system; a Siegel colorizer; audiotape recorder, equalizer and mixer; an 8400 portapak with 3450 camera; and a tivicon camera.

Interested artists can submit an example of their recent work (slides, 1/2" EIAJ videotape, photos, scripts, etc.) and a letter indicating anticipated projects utilizing the Lab throughout the year. Applications may be submitted at any time.
