Although the entire operations will necessitate a very large budget-(approx. \$40,000) a smaller sum could well be put to either a nec essar component of the entire group as a sound system of amplifier and speakers, and tape recorder, all for approx. \$2,000, or else the possibilty of funding a single artists in a special project working through our workshop, such as Mr. Benedict Tatti, an abstract video artistm, an art teacher in Art and Design High School for mor than 30 years, also a souppositing with incredible video structures.
