MICHAEL TSCHUDIN

Michael Tschudin is currently musical director for both the Mercer Art Center Complex and the Off-Broadway musical, "Love Me, Love My Children". He has several recording and performing bands: The Midnite Opera Company, The Rhythm Section, and Cynara - the latter having two albums to their credit. Michael was a record producer at Vanguard Records (1968-70) and at Capitol Records (1971).

Previously, he toured with the Festival Casals Orchestra (1958-62) and studied with Pablo Casals, Hector Campos-Parsi, Leonard Bernstein and other musicians and composers. He graduated from Harvard University in 1966, where he was active in the areas of acoustic design, music from classical to musical comedy and drama. Mr. Tschudin taught music at the Horace Mann school, and dramatic literature at N.Y.U. in 1967, but has abandoned teaching to work on his own projects.
